Discussion / Objective

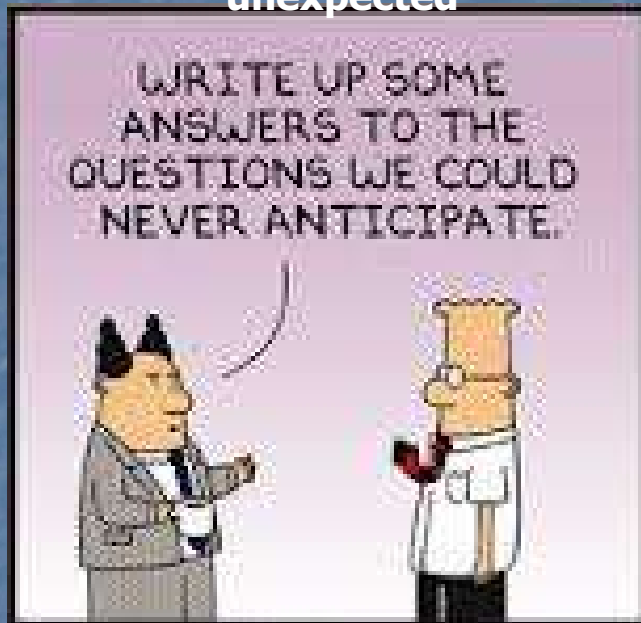

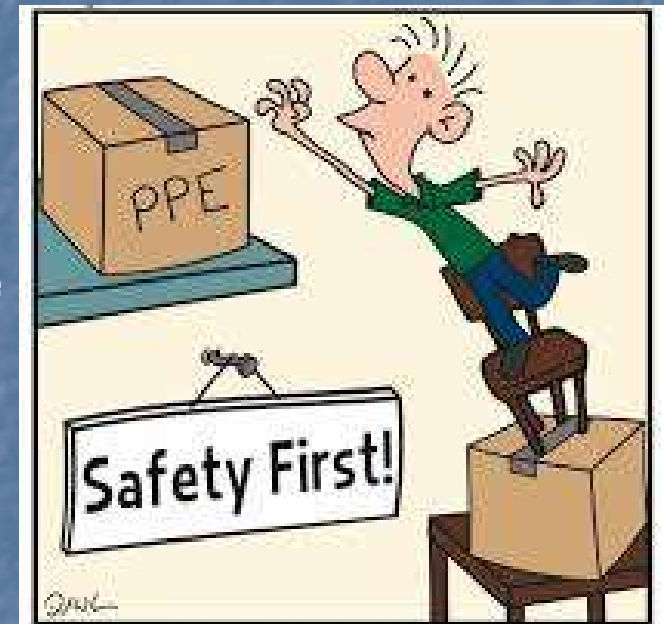
Be prepared to manage the unexpected



Avoid the costly blame game

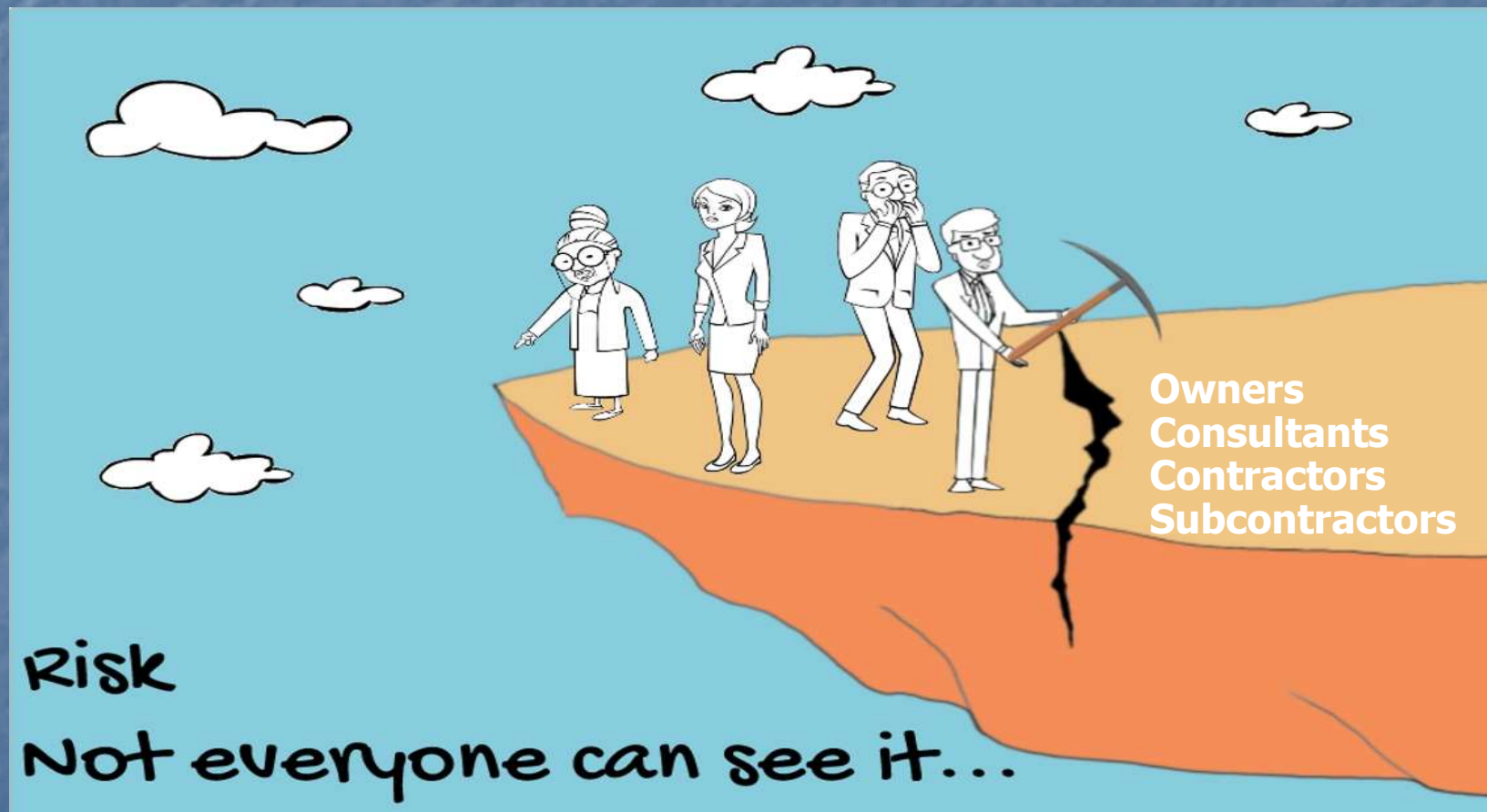


A Safe Project = A Successful Project
